Q: Please provide details of the products and sales amount related to unmanned vehicle

programs in the defense sector.

A: Our company is participates in the unmanned aircraft program through its core competencies,

particularly in power systems and actuators. We expect unmanned aircraft to become

mainstream worldwide in the near future, so we anticipate making a significant contribution to

sales volume.

Q: Is your company considering M&A or capital alliances as you work to expand applications to

mid- and back-end processes in the semiconductor sector and develop new actuators?

A: We are strategically pursuing M&A not only in the semiconductor sector but also in power

electronics and robotics, with the aim of strengthening our technical capabilities. In addition,

we will consider partnerships with other companies as appropriate, depending on the specifics

of each project.

Q: With regard to the expansion of production capacity in the defense sector, while 40 billion

yen is sufficient for the fiscal year ending March 2028, is there a risk of insufficiency under the

next defense build-up plan from the fiscal year ending March 2029 onward? When do you plan

to make new investments, and what will be the amount?

A: We will assess the situation and make decisions once the details of the next defense build-

up plan are finalized.

Q: Profitability in the defense sector has improved, but why are the targets in the medium-term

plan still set at a low level?

A: It is true that profitability in the defense sector has historically been low. We have set our

performance targets conservatively; however, we will make every effort to significantly exceed

these targets.
